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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Please read all of the instructions before installation. **IMPORTANT:** Before you begin, turn off the water supply.

Step 1

- Wall lining hole should be cut or finished as per the dimension shown in the diagram below.
- Cut off the threaded nipple 15 ±2mm from the wall lining and apply thread seal tape to ensure a good seal.



Step 2

- Insert faceplate o-ring into the groove in the faceplate and slide the faceplate over the nipple.
- Secure faceplate in place by screwing the inlet connector onto the nipple.



Step 3

- Ensure outlet bracket o-ring is located on faceplate.
- Firmly push the outlet bracket onto the inlet connector and secure in place by tightening the grub screw firmly using the hex key provided.



Step 4

- Connect hose to outlet bracket and handset.
- Ensure swivelling cone is connected to the handset.



Care and Cleaning

A filter washer should be installed in the hose cone on the water outlet and it should be cleaned periodically.
